



Tour of Reclaimed Gregg River and Luscar Mines and Operating Cheviot Mine

Thursday, September 22, 2011

Depart from Chateau Lake Louise at 6:00 am

Return to Chateau Lake Louise at 10:30 pm

Minimum: 20

Maximum: 50

Field Tour Cost: \$ 300 (Cdn) (includes breakfast, lunch and light dinner)

Equipment Required: All attendees must bring and wear steel-toed boots

Description of Field Tour:

Hosted by Environment Leaders from both Teck Resources Ltd. (Teck) and Coal Valley Resources Inc. (CVRI), visitors will travel south of Hinton to Teck's Cardinal River Operations, where we will view the Cheviot mine, a producing metallurgical coal operation. We'll then return to the north to Cardinal River Operations' Luscar Mine and the CVRI, Gregg River Mine, where significant reclamation activities post-mining are underway or have occurred. Together, these adjacent properties, when fully reclaimed, will provide a contiguous bloc of over 7,000 hectares of post-mined landscape consisting of open grasslands, re-established watersheds, reforested and undisturbed forested islands. Particular emphasis on this tour will be regarding land use planning: these landscapes with their current values and future opportunities for wildlife protection and public access.
