GUIDED HIKES



MOUNTAIN HERITAGE PROGRAM

These programs are offered between June 1st and September 30th. Participation in our hiking program requires no previous experience, just certain levels of physical fitness. While some hikes may appear physically demanding to inexperienced hikers, our guides take pride in managing the pace and duration of the hikes to suit the abilities of all participants. In inclement weather, the guide may offer alternative adventure opportunities. Technical equipment, boots, rain gear and backpacks are provided. Please note there is a 12- hour cancellation policy in effect. Children under the age of 8 may only participate in customized adventures (see below).

WHAT TO WEAR?

The trick to comfortable hiking is to dress in non-cotton layers. Walking shorts are fine, depending on weather conditions. A sweater, wind/water proof jacket, sunglasses, sunscreen and hat are recommended. Make sure your footwear is flat-soled, sturdy running shoes or hiking boots are best. Finally, don't forget to bring a bottle of water - and your camera, of course. You may wish purchase a packed lunch to take with you from the Chateau Deli or alternatively eat at one of the teahouse, which only accept Canadian or US cash. By hiking with one of our guides, you are treated to the benefits of historical and ecological commentary.

Half Day Hikes

Lake Agnes and the Tea House

This lovely walk is one of the most popular hikes in the Banff National Park for one good reason: Our first switch back lets us look down on the turquoise waters of Lake Louise. Continuing upward, we pass Mirror Lake tucked under the sheer cliffs of the Big Beehive. At the Tea House we will "tarry-a-while" and enjoy the breathtaking backdrop.

Full Day Hikes

The Plain of Six Glaciers and the Tea house

If you only had time for one hike in the Canadian Rockies, this would be it. This spectacular hike can be turned into a loop that includes walking up to Mirror Lake then traversing across the rarely traveled "Highline Trail." After conquering the ascent, we arrive at the Tea House for fresh baked goods.

CHOOSE YOUR OWN ADVENTURE HIKE

Join one of our accredited naturalists for a hike of your choosing. The first guests to book decide where this day goes. Meet your guide in the morning or consult with them the night before to tailor a hike to your abilities and interest. Our options are endless! Half day or full day. We can go for a classic walk up to one of teahouses, challenge the summit of magnificent Mt Fairview or drive away and hike one of the more remote trails in the park. The choice is yours!

RIDE THE DIVIDE

Journey with your guide through an active wildlife corridor and look for signs of animals, especially tracks and scat. Learn about this area's most famous resident: the Grizzly bear. Discover how small changes in our behaviour will keep both bears and people safe. After a pleasant downhill run we end up at the British Columbia/Alberta border and the amazing feature called the Great Divide.

VOYAGEUR CANOE EXPERIENCE

Paddle into history on our authentic 26' cedar strip and canvas canoe on the emerald waters of Lake Louise.

Canoes have been part of experiencing this spectacular lake for over a century. As you journey across the lake your guide and canoe historian will share stories of the canoe from native peoples, early explorers, fur traders and by people who just love to be on the water.

Paddle the day away on the beautiful and always breathtaking Lake Louise. Enjoy stunning scenery, aquamarine water and the dramatic peaks of the Victoria Glacier. Canoe rentals are available at the boathouse, located on the west shore of Lake Louise. Each canoe may be rented at an hourly rate and can hold either three adults or two adults and two small children under 55lbs/25kg each. Reservations are only accepted for the sunrise canoe excursions. Canoe rentals are based on a first come first served basis. Photos of you and your family partaking in this scenic excursion are available. No cancellation policy.



Cost: \$45 per hour per canoe or \$35 per half hour per canoe.

Early Bird Special: 8:30 am- 10:00 am: \$40 per hour per canoe or \$30 per half hour per canoe.

After an early morning wake-up call, venture outside for this unforgettable experience of canoeing on Lake Louise at the break of dawn. Enjoy the stillness of the water, the crispness of the air, and the great photo opportunity this excursion affords. Reservations are required at least 12 hours in advance, tours operate weather permitting. Cancellation policy – 8:00pm the night before the excursion or else the full amount will be charged to your room.

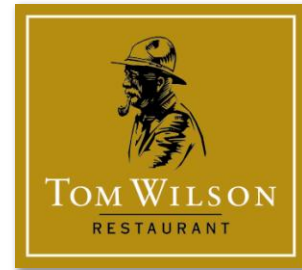

Experience the thrills and white water of the historic Kicking Horse River! No previous experience is required for these half-day excursions. Choose between the exhilarating White water Exciter, guaranteed to soak and thrill, or the fun and informative Gentle trip, ideal for the younger or nervous rafter. Full day and higher category rapid excursion are also available. Included in the trip are lifejackets, wetsuits, fleece sweaters, wetsuit booties, helmets, and spray jackets. Guests need to bring a towel and wear their swimsuits. Hot and cold beverages, along with baked treats and fresh fruit await you at the conclusion of your trip as well as warm, comfortable change rooms to store your clothes while rafting and change in after the conclusion of your trip. The minimum age required for the White water Exciter trip is 12 years; children must weigh at least 90 lbs. The minimum age for the Gentle trip is 8 years. Transportation from The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise is included, or if you have your own vehicle and wish to drive to the River Base Day lodge, 45 minutes west, the cost will be slightly lower, see prices below. If you will be driving, please see the Concierge team for a map to the meeting site. Reservations are required and can be made at the Wild Water Adventures desk on the lobby level of the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise. Please note a 24-hour cancellation policy is in effect. We mean the river. . . it's a real buzz to flow downstream completely at-one with the current, riding through swirls, boils, holes and waves. Professional guides will give an informative training session in the slow backwater eddies before you venture into the main stream. On the river your guide and safety kayaker will show you the way, giving continuous instruction and providing safety. Try catching eddies, surfing waves and riding holes! 24-hour cancellation policy in effect. Boogie boards, booties, flippers, wetsuits and helmets are supplied. Please bring a swim suit, towel and warm clothes. Minimum age 14 years. Must be physically fit and able to swim.
